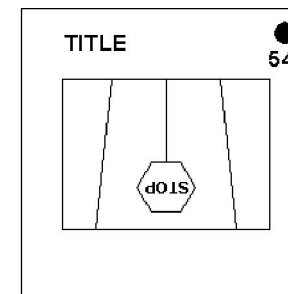

Monthly Competitions

The monthly competition year runs from June until May. Competitions are held as listed. A "members judging night" is held once during the year. Each monthly competition consists of an open subject. Set subject competitions are also held as listed in syllabus. Members may submit up to 2 images in all sections. Entries for each month must be submitted by the fourth Thursday of the preceding month. Trophies are awarded for the yearly aggregate in each section.

Open Subject Competitions - are judged in three sections based on the following formats:

* **Large Prints:** Maximum print size is 40 x 50 cm, and all Prints must be mounted.

* **Small Prints:** Maximum print size is 12.7 x 18cm or Panorama. Panorama prints must not exceed 25cm in length, or be larger than 225 square cms. Prints must be mounted, maximum mount size is 20 x 25 cm.

* **All Print Entries** must be clearly marked on the back with the member's competition number in the top left hand corner with the print title below the competition number.

* **Projected Images:** includes Slides and Digital Projected Images. Digital projected images may be enhanced or manipulated using image editing software, but the original image must have been made by the entrant. The maximum horizontal dimension is 1024 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 768 pixels. Files must be saved as 8 bit JPEG and sRGB colour space at 72 to 100 ppi, saved at a suitable JPEG quality to give a file no greater than 250 Kb. Files must be named in the formats below.

Open: nn_yyyyymm_Title_OP.jpg **S.S:** nn_yyyyymm_Title_SS.jpg. Images are projected on a black b/g using PicturesToExe software. Images may include a border, which must fit within the max. dims. If your Competition No. is under 10 put a zero before your number.

For **Slides** see information on inside top right of syllabus.

Set Subject Competition - definitions listed if available. Each member may submit up to two entries in any one competition in any combination of formats.

Scoring Projected Images and Prints are scored out of fifteen points (no half points will be awarded).

Eligibility for re-entry - Entries that have scored nine points or less in a previous monthly competition may be re-submitted in one subsequent competition. Entries that have scored more than nine points are ineligible for re-submission (except set subjects – see below). Entries that have scored more than nine points in an open subject competition may be entered in a set subject competition. Entries that have scored more than nine points in a set subject competition may be entered in an open competition.

Image of the Year

The Image of the Year competitions are held in the three open competition sections.

Only projected images and prints that have been entered in monthly competitions in the current competition year are eligible for entry.

Projected Images and Prints previously entered in the Image of the Year Competitions are not eligible for re-entry.

Entries for the Image of the Year competition are due by the date in the syllabus.

AGM Landscape/Coastline Competition

This special set subject competition is held each year in conjunction with the Annual General Meeting. Each member may submit up to four entries in any combination of formats. Entries for the Landscape/Coastline Competition are due by the last Thursday in March or as determined by the competition secretary. Entries in this competition are only eligible for the Image of The Year Competitions if they have also been entered in a monthly competition.

Landscape/Coastline:- A picture featuring natural scenery of the terrain, coastal features or shoreline. A tree or trees, people or buildings may be included but should not dominate or take up a significant portion of the image.

Urban Landscapes are not eligible for entry.

Members Judging Night Competition

Entries from this Competition may also be entered in any Monthly Comp. regardless of the score received as they are not included in the Yearly Aggregate. They are not eligible for the Image of the Year Competitions, if they have only been entered in this competition
